Injuries are thinning out bareback riding competition

Bumps and bruises are just part of the hazards of rodeo, but for Montana bareback riders the injuries have sidelined many top competitors including the top three in Montana Circuit Standings.

Two top 15 bareback riders Andy Bolich and Scott Owens both have suffered career ending injuries. Andy was seriously injured at the MPRF Finals last January. Placing last fall during the NILE, Andy is currently ranked 15th. Scott broke his back this summer during the Stanford Pro Rodeo and is currently ranked third.

Randy VandenBos suffered a knee injury and also damaged his artery in his leg during the Baker pro rodeo and required surgery in Billings.

Ben Wrzesinski of Helena is home re-cooperating from a broken leg, Buck Lunak also is home mending a broken bone.

Others are mending pulled muscles and dislocations. The bareback riding typically has a smaller field of competitors, these serious injuries will have a major effect on the field of riders eligible to compete at the Montana Pro Rodeo Finals coming up in January.

This year around the state of Montana, many of you may have witnessed a crew of jubilant, rowdy women taking part in a rodeo clinic pre-performance in the arenas of the Helena Last Chance Stampede, the Great Falls Big Sky Pro Rodeo Roundup, and the Missoula Stampede. Most likely they were decked out in pink, and the crowd at the rodeo was a lot louder on those nights.

I introduce you to the women of Chicks N Chaps! Local women pay their entry fees to come into the arena before the evening rodeo performance and learn about the sport of rodeo from professional cowboys and stock contractors. Whether the ladies are solely interested in learning the sport, or getting to hang out with attractive clinicians- it doesn't matter. The ultimate objective is still the same: to raise a LOT of money for breast cancer. Last year at the Missoula Stampede, Chicks N Chaps raised about \$20,000 for the disease. The best part is these proceeds benefit local breast cancer patients.

The concept originated in Missoula and now has added clinics in Great Falls, Helena, and Kalispell. I have seen first hand women getting "behind the chute" tours, stock briefing by PRCA stock contractors like Ike Sankey, ladies trying on some of the bullrider's chaps and getting some lessons on the bucking barrel, as well as having the chance to try the roping dummies with successful timed event athletes like Mike Beers. In Helena, volunteers built the ladies an "8 second saloon", where they satisfied their thirst with cocktails and pink beer.

I am so proud to be from a state where people take the initiative. Chicks N Chaps started as a tiny vision. Nobody knew it would spread like wildfire! I guarantee this idea will take the world of rodeo by storm. And the best part is – it started in Montana. Chicks N Chaps is here to stay because everybody wins: female fans, the sport of rodeo, and most importantly, your sisters, cousins, mothers, daughters, and friends who have breast cancer.
